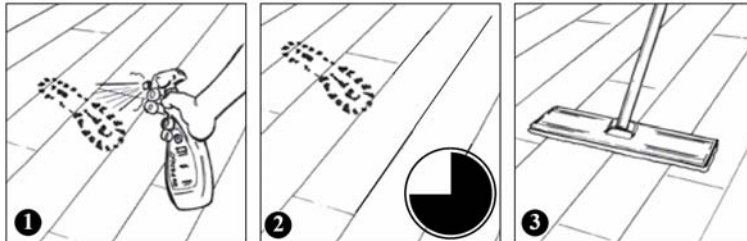


## Ordinary cleaning

Vacuum (without the beater bar) or sweep the floor using the Pergo mop to remove dirt and dust. Occasionally wipe with a damp Pergo cloth. As



1. Spray Pergo Floor Cleaner directly on the stain/spillage.
2. Let Pergo Floor Cleaner dissolve stains for a few minutes.
3. Clean the floor with damp mop (using only water).

## No wax or polish

Your Pergo floor should not be waxed or polished. Never scrub with steel wool or any other coarse material as this may effect the appearance of the texture.



## Matt textures

In general, dirt sticks harder to floors with matt textures. Therefore, we recommend that you clean the floor more regularly and use Pergo Floor Cleaner on the entire floor/area to dissolve dirt stuck to the surface.

## Polished texture

Dried watermarks are often more visible on polished textures. Therefore, for best results, always wipe with dry mop after damp cleaning.

## Floors with beveled edge

Floors with beveled edges are more sensitive to water since the bevel acts as a pocket where water can collect. Therefore, never clean these types of floors with a lot of water. Instead use a well-wrung damp mop and make sure no water is collected in the bevel.

## Protect your floor

Although laminate floors are very resistance to wear and scratches, use felt pads under furniture legs, and place pads or plastic cups under chair legs, as an added precaution. Always use a doormat in front of entrance as well.
